Governor will receive H1N1 vaccine at the Capitol

Governor Joe Manchin will receive the swine flu vaccination at the public H1N1 immunization clinic scheduled at the Capitol for residents and public employees.

The flu shot clinic will begin with Gov. Joe Manchin receiving the first H1N1 shot at 11 a.m. in the Governor's Reception Room. In addition, the governor and State Health Officer Dr. Cathy Slemple will give brief remarks. This will be a photo opportunity/media availability for the media.

The public flu shot clinic will be held immediately after the ceremonial injections until 2 p.m. in the Capitol Rotunda. Kanawha-Charleston Health Department will offer H1N1 and a limited number of seasonal flu vaccines during that time.
